The National Maternal Mental Health Hotline provides **24/7**, free, confidential support before, during, and after pregnancy. The Hotline offers callers:

- Phone or text access to professional counselors
- Real-time support, information, and resources
- Response within a few minutes, 24 hours a day, 7 days a week
- Referrals to local and telehealth providers and support groups
- Culturally sensitive support
- Counselors who speak English and Spanish
- Interpreter services in 60 languages



Maternal and Infant Health Mapping Tool

The Maternal and Infant Health Mapping Tool is an interactive online tool that allows users to create and customize county-level maps on maternal and infant health. Users can explore the geographic relationships between maternal and infant health indicators, health resources, and demographics. The tool was designed to help federal, state, and local decision-makers and others visualize maternal and infant health factors to assist in understanding need and targeting resources.

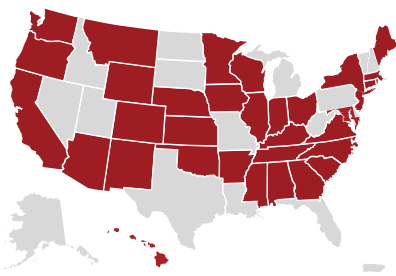
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Screening and Treatment for Maternal Mental Health and Substance Use Disorders Program



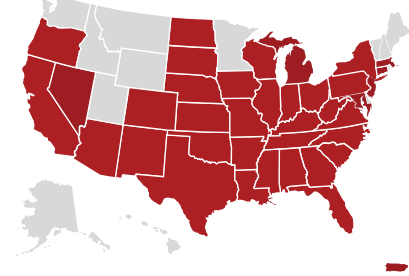
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State Maternal Health Innovation Program



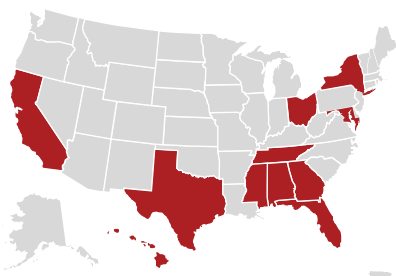

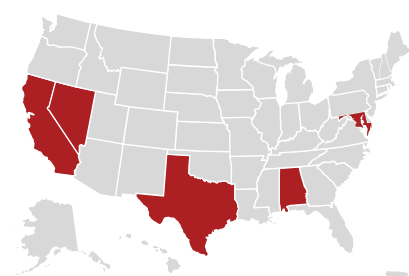
